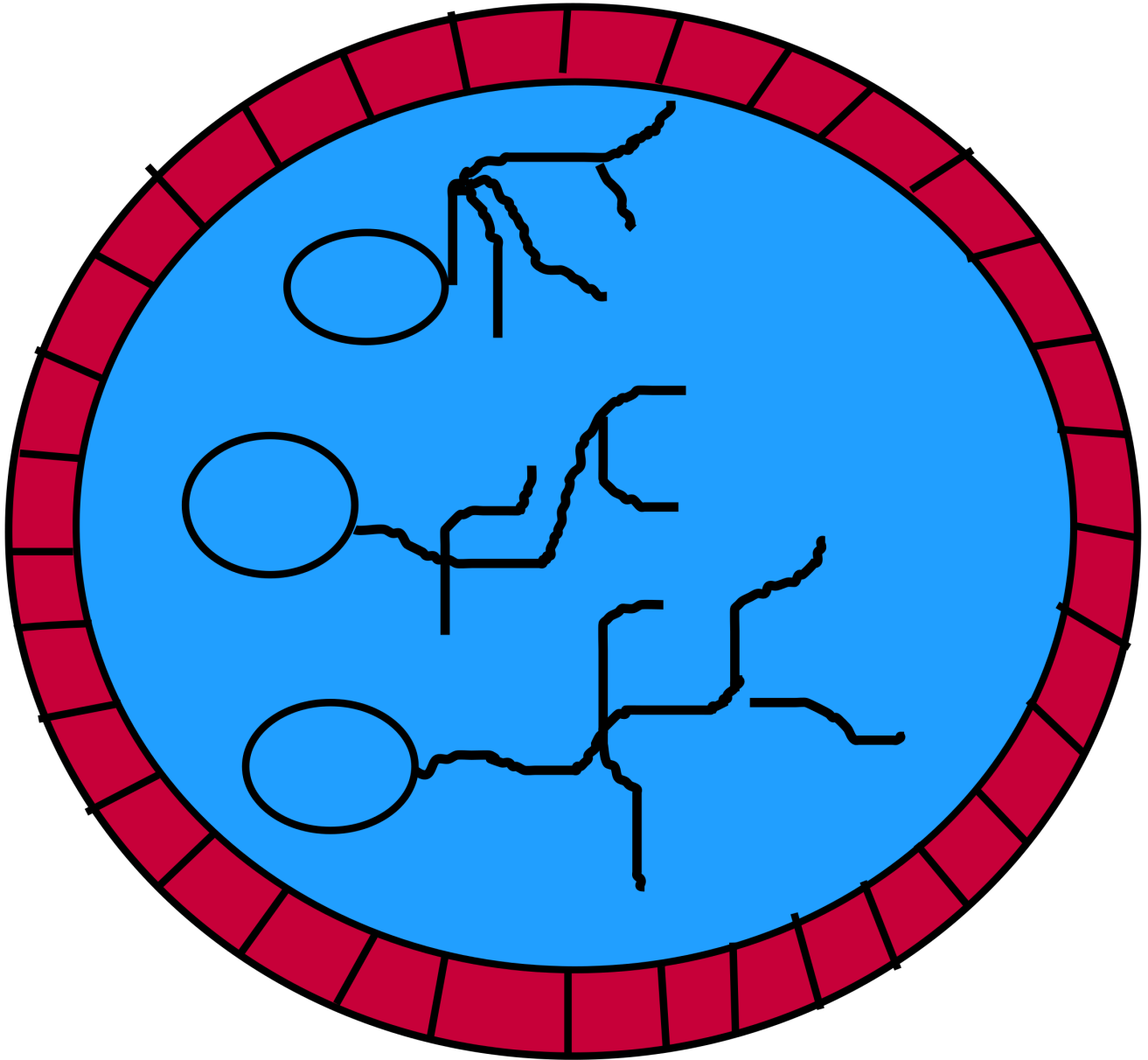


this is a zine about working,

awake the day

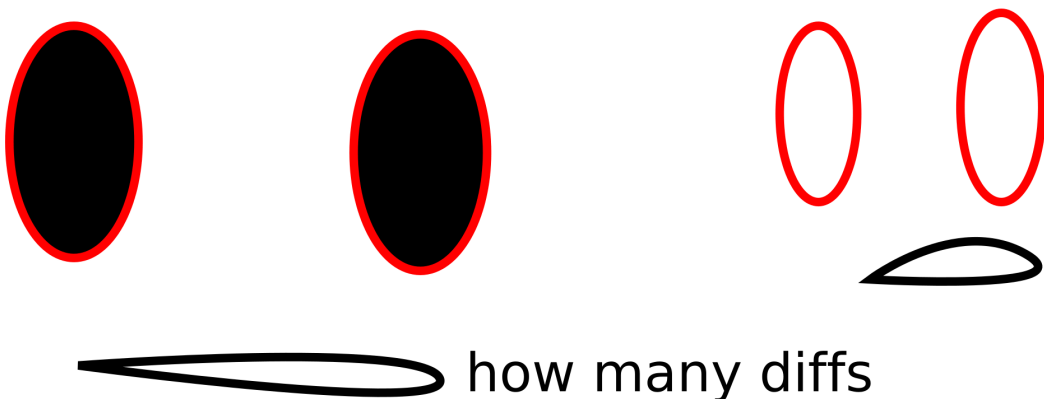
when the sun rises my face depresses further
